Inclusion NB supports students with an intellectual or developmental disability, aged 18-30, who wish to pursue post-secondary education and have been accepted to the school of their choice.

Our team members help students to achieve their goals through:

- Identifying the supports they need to have a positive and successful postsecondary education experience;
- Assisting in the preparation of applications for financial assistance, such as New Brunswick student loans;
- Providing ongoing support during their post-secondary career and keeping upto-date on their progress;
- Assisting the student in identifying and coordinating work placements to gain experience; and
- Assisting the student in securing employment opportunities in their field of study following graduation.

JUST ENOUGH SUPPORT

Inclusion NB's Post-Secondary Facilitators and students plan together using the *Just Enough Support* model. This recognizes the importance of seeking the right balance of natural supports, like friends and family, and accessing different types of technology and community-based services.

The purpose of this approach is to build bridges and help the student expand their social relationships and develop their personal autonomy and independence.
